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Additional Information:

If you see any **clashes with tests**, please talk to your classroom teacher **by Friday 12 June** about the possibility of sitting an alternate time during Test week. It is the teacher's decision as to where and when the alternative test will be scheduled within Test Week.

Rules for students during test week (test period).

1. All tests will be held within the school. Check the test timetable to see where the test is scheduled.
2. Students must sit the test at the scheduled time. Written/medical documentation may be required to explain any absence.
3. Students are encouraged to arrive at least 10 minutes before the starting time of the test but may not enter the room until directed by the supervising teacher.
4. Students who arrive late for their test may not be given an extension of time. Students who arrive later than 15 minutes after the commencement of the test may not be permitted to enter the examination room. Students in this situation should report immediately to the appropriate Director for alternative arrangements if allowed.
5. Students will be required to sit in the area assigned to their class.
6. In general, students must stay in the examination for the entire duration. Refer to individual examination conditions for any alternative arrangements to this.
7. It is the student's responsibility to provide their own equipment during tests. Gungahlin College is not responsible for providing stationery or calculators for students. If for any reason a student does not have this equipment, then prior to the day of the test they will need to talk to their classroom teacher to see if there is a possibility to borrow resources.
8. Calculators must be scientific and non-programmable unless stated otherwise by the teacher.
9. Students are not permitted to have access to (nor play) iPods, iPhones, iPads, laptops, MP3 players, CDs or similar devices during any test.
10. Students are not permitted to use an electronic dictionary during any test. Students are permitted to use a language dictionary in non-electronic form.
11. The Board of Senior Secondary Studies requires that students are to substantially complete all assessment items. This means that students need to make a reasonable attempt at answering many questions on the test – otherwise it is possible that an 'insubstantial attempt' is issued.
12. Students are not permitted to talk to, or communicate with, anyone during the test, except a supervising teacher. Students who are found communicating will have their papers annotated and may have a mark penalty imposed. This may include the loss of all marks.

Absences from tests:

If, due to unforeseen circumstances, a student has cause to be absent from a test, the student must notify the teacher (via email) and college (via GNGCAbsences@ed.act.edu.au) on the day and provide an expected date of return. The teacher may then negotiate with the House Co a later date to complete the assessment item or organise alternative arrangements.
